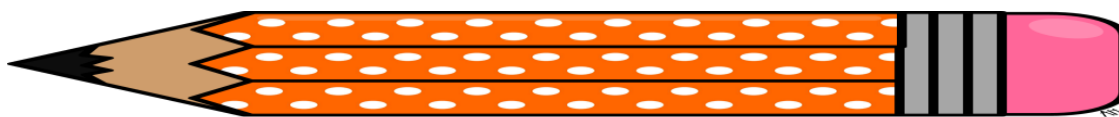

CHRISTMAS CONCERT AND CHRISTMAS CAROLS

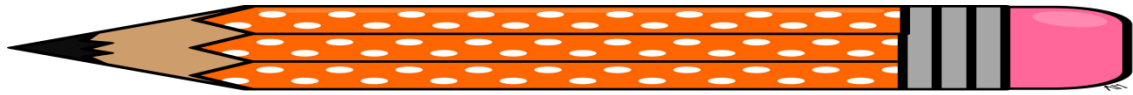
Our end of year Christmas Concert this year will be a truly special event.
